Title: A RESOLUTION TO CREATE THE SEQUATCHIE COUNTY "9-1-1" EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS DISTRICT, AND TO CONFIRM THE APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS THERETO.

WHEREAS, the voters of Sequatchie County approved a referendum on March 14, 2000, to authorize the creation of the Sequatchie County "9-1-1" Emergency Communications District ("District") for the purpose of providing the life-saving 9-1-1 service to all citizens of the county; and,

WHEREAS, State law provides for creation of the District by the County Commission upon approval of the voters and the appointment of members of the Board of Directors("the Board") of the District; and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with the State law, the County Executive has appointed the persons named below for the terms indicated for each, subject to confirmation by this Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THIS COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY, IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

1. That we do hereby create the Sequatchie County 9-1-1 Emergency Communications District to include all parts of Sequatchie County, including municipal and incorporated areas without exception;
2. That we do hereby confirm the following appointments for the initial terms shown below, after which all terms shall be four (4) years in length:
