# 2013 Economic Impact of Tourism in Sequatchie County

- Generated \$6.38 MILLION in direct tourism expenditures
- Generated 30 jobs
- > Produced \$890,000 in payroll
- Created \$460,000 in local tax revenue
- Created \$350,000 in state tax revenue

## PER HOUSEHOLD

# As a result of taxes generated by tourist activity in the county:

- Each household pays \$147.46 less in local and state taxes
- Each household pays \$83.74 less in local county taxes
- Each household pays \$63.71 less in state taxes

#### ON AN AVERAGE DAY

## On An Average Day In 2013, Tourist Spending in Sequatchie County

- > Generated \$17,479 in daily expenditures
- > Produced \$2,438 in daily payroll
- > Created \$1,260 daily in local tax revenues
- > Created \$958 daily in state tax revenues
